

# Unsuccessful Third Parties of the 19th Century

The Getalong Party (1860-1860): Rendered immediately obsolete by the Constitutional Unionists.

The Public Osculation Party (1898-1899): A one-plank party dedicated to the permittance of necking in public areas. Of course, none of the supporters were old enough to vote at the time.
